

AHT Project livelihood promotion initiative:

Being encouraged by the progress of the AHT support project, the beneficiaries themselves are expanding the horticulture plot sizes and purchased seeds for which Pro Rural supported with the transportation. **Ginger and Pineapple** Plantation programme undertaken on **9th June** in **Athibung Block, Peren District, Nagaland**. The activity strengthened sustainable livelihoods, encouraging vulnerable households to cultivate high-value horticultural crops with strong income-generating potential. Beneficiaries received quality planting materials along with practical guidance on proper planting techniques, crop management, and sustainable farming practices.



HEALTH OUTREACH

Village level health camp were conducted from **18–20 June 2026** at **New Mpai Namchi, Old Mpai**

Village, and New Peren Village under Peren Block, Peren District.

The camp provided general medicine and eye consultation services, with a total of **141** beneficiaries receiving medical consultation, screening, treatment, and health advice. Reading glasses were also distributed to elderly individuals with age-related vision difficulties. On request of the Medical Officer (MO), an awareness session on Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs), was conducted at New Mpai Namchi.



23 June 2026: A Free Medical Health Camp was conducted in observance of **International Widows' Day** at **Signal Angami Village, Dimapur**, in collaboration

with **Circle of Hope** and with support of Doctor and nurses from the **Urban Primary Health Centre, Duncan, Dimapur**.

A total of **62** beneficiaries (especially, widows and their family) availed general medicine, dental, and eye consultation services, along with free blood tests and free medicines.



Pro Rural convened a BftW staff review meeting of the four states to assess the progress of ongoing project activities across the implementation districts (**Nagaland, Meghalaya, Mizoram & Assam**).

A district-level program was organized on **26/6/2026** in **East Jaintia Hills, Meghalaya**, bringing together government officials, community representatives, and stakeholders.

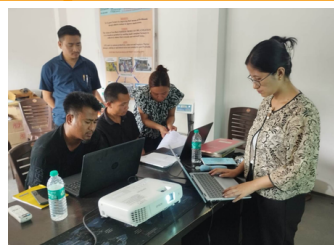
The program focused sustainable community development through sessions on gender equity and social inclusion, disaster risk reduction and climate resilience, rural livelihood opportunities under NRLM, and social protection schemes.

Pro Rural, supported by Brot für die Welt (BftW) and the Department of District Disaster Management, organized **District-Level Disaster Management Workshop – Peren** on **30th/6/2026** at **Samziuram Village Council Hall, Peren**. The workshop enhanced participants' knowledge of disaster preparedness, emergency response, first aid, and fire safety through technical presentations and practical demonstrations by the District Disaster Management Authority, Home Guards & Civil Defence, and Fire Station Jalukie.



MIS Portal & Tally Training for FPOs

CBBO Pro Rural conducted a one-day MIS Portal and Tally Software Training on **17 June 2026** at the Peren FPO Office for representatives from **Athibung, Peren, Jalukie, and Tening FPOs**. A total of 10 people were equipped with practical skills to update the FPO MIS Portal, and manage financial records in Tally.



Participants also received practical guidance on Tally installation, company creation, ledger management, voucher entries, and bank statement recording for **FY 2025–26**.

Azim Premji Philantropic Initiatives (A.P.P.I.)

On 6th June 2026, as part of a convergence initiative between Pro Rural and the Sericulture Department, Peren District, around 35,000–40,000 (approximately) silkworm eggs were distributed to selected 10 progressive farmers from three villages of the Nsong area. This initiative aimed to promote sericulture-based livelihoods and strengthen income-generating opportunities for rural households.

The visit focused on assessing achievements, identifying implementation challenges, and discussing strategic priorities to strengthen the delivery of Vitamin A Supplementation (VAS) services across the project's pilot areas.



In the month of June, **11** community awareness were carried out across pilot areas (**Chumoukedima, Dhansiripar, Kuhuboto and Burma Camp**) with a turn up of **191** participants in total.

Environment & Waste Management

A community awareness program on the **World Environment Day 2026**, themed, "**Inspired by Nature. For our Climate. For our Future**" was organised by Pro Rural in collaboration

with SEWA and NEN on **5th June 2026** at **Pro Rural office**. A total of **40** people were present for the program.



On **15th June 2026**, HWA team, in collaboration with Prodigals Home and the Food Safety Department, Government of Nagaland, organized a **Food Safety**

Awareness and Sensitization Workshop at Prodigals Home, Dimapur, for HWA beneficiaries. The workshop enhance participants' knowledge of food safety, hygiene, proper food handling, storage practices, and sanitation. It also encouraged safe food preparation and healthy consumption habits, enabling beneficiaries to maintain food quality, protect public health, and support sustainable livelihood activities.



On **29th and 30th June 2026**, the HWA team conducted a dog rescue operation by rescuing dogs from suppliers. A total of **19** dogs were successfully rescued and safely kept under the shelter. This rescue effort reflects HWA's continued commitment to animal welfare and its mission to prevent cruelty, safeguard vulnerable animals, and provide them with a safe and compassionate environment.
